

We will use NetBeans as the IDE.

(You are welcome to use Eclipse, but during class demos, I will be using NetBeans).

NetBeans IDE:

Download and install the NetBeans with JDK 8 package.

You should be done now!

If you run into problems, you can first download the Java JDK (see Eclipse directions below), and then the “Java SE” IDE from here <https://netbeans.org/downloads/> .

Eclipse:

First, you will need to install Java (JDK):

(Even if you have a Mac, or have previous JDK)

We need Java SE, preferably Java SE 8 (or higher).

Second, install Eclipse:

<https://eclipse.org/downloads/>

Seems like the current version is Neon:



Get Eclipse Neon

Install your favorite Eclipse packages.

You will be prompted by installer to choose the IDE environment, and you should choose the Java IDE for developers (NOT the EE). See screenshot below.



Just choose it, and the installation will proceed.
